Report

E.H.B. had filed most of his papers systematically, and had established a working pattern which I consider very satisfactory and have tried to use as much as possible. The contents of all the files have been checked and changes have been made where there was any confusion. Bundles of unfiled papers were either put into the existing system or were put into new files based on the existing pattern.

Between the Personal Correspondence (under "Correspondents") and "Diocesan" or "Subject" files there is naturally some overlapping. Where this seemed important, I have put "See also:-" slips inside the "Correspondent" file, but this cross-referencing is by no means exhaustive.

I have worked on the principle of "keeping everything" rather than of selecting and destroying.

Mrs. Thorn will also return transcriptions of articles and speeches etc. which she has been using. Originals of these will, of course, be with the collected papers.

- 4. In Diocesan Archives at Newcastle there is a file on the transfer of St. John's College from Armidale to Morpeth.
- The A.B.C. Archives in Sydney probably have tapes of the broadcast talks and sermons by E.H.B., copies of many of which are with the papers. In addition the A.B.C. is preparing a programme on the life and work of E.H.B. which is to be broadcast early next year (1968). This will include a recording made many years ago by E.H.B. at the request of Kenneth Henderson. The recording is marked "To be played after his death". There is also in the archives a recording of an interview made by M.H.B. with Wal Eastman of Canberra on the jubilee of his ordination. The A.B.C. in Newcastle has made a recording of tributes to E.H.B. by his son, his brother and two of his students. This has not yet been broadcast. A copy is held by Mr. C.A. Burgmann, 19 Ocean View Parade, Charlestown, N.S.W.
- 6. Among some unfiled papers was a letter, dated December 18th, 1963 from the Research Assistant, Department of Folitical Science, A.N.U., indicating the existence of a folder of letters written to E.H.B. about his stand on the Referendum Campaign of 1950 concerning the Communist Party Dissolution Bill. It seems certain that this folder was returned to M.H.B. by the A.N.U. but so far it has not been found. Its contents would obviously be of considerable interest.
